1. The WFPHA Organizational Excellence Award

1.1. Nature of the Award

The WFPHA Organizational Excellence Award was created to recognize outstanding contributions to public health by a not-for-profit, non-governmental organization (NGO) or institution/entity working to promote health, to prevent disease and injury, and to ensure conditions in which people can be safe and healthy.

1.2 Nomination & Selection Process

WFPHA's members, members of the Governing Council and WFPHA Committees are encouraged to propose an organization as a candidate for the Organizational Excellence Award. The Awards Committee will receive the nominations and recommend an awardee, to be subsequently approved by the Governing Council.

The nominated organization or entity must have demonstrated a significant contribution in the field of public health and contributed in a special may to improve the community health and well-being. The organization/entity must have at least 10 years' experience in delivering, managing or putting into place high quality and effective public health services or action.

To make a nomination, the following forms and documents must be submitted by email or by mail to the WFPHA's headquarters at the address below. Please note that the submission must include an electronic signature.

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2. The Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence in Global Health

2.1. Nature of the award

The WFPHA Lifetime Achievement award is to be presented to an outstanding public health professional, who has made an extraordinary contribution to WFPHA in its role of improving global health including its member organizations. In exceptional circumstances, the award could be made posthumously.

2.2. Nomination & Selection process:

WFPHA's members, members of the Governing Council and WFPHA Committees are encouraged to propose an individual as a candidate for the Lifetime Achievement Award. The Awards Committee will receive the nominations and recommend an awardee, to be subsequently approved by the Governing Council.

Each nominee will be evaluated on his/her own merit, and generally should meet most of these criteria to a variable degree:

- Extraordinary contribution to WFPHA -including its member organizations- in its √ role of improving global health.
- ✓ At least 20 years' experience in public health
- ✓ High standard of professionalism and a track record of building public health capacity and/or influencing health policy
- ✓ A continuing long distinguished career in international/global health with exceptional achievements.
- ✓ Quality/creativity/innovativeness of the individual's contributions to public health education, practice or research that shaped the directions of this field.
- Excellent contributions to the development and strengthening of international health ✓ organizations or institutions.
- Recognized contributions as a leader, visionary and role model. ✓

- □ A letter from the nominator explaining why the nominee meets the criteria for this award, and including:

 - Relevant publications on particular achievements on which nominations are based.
